

THE CHARGES AGAINST A RECTOR.

“MORE THAN NOT GUILTY.”

There was loud applause in the Consistory Court at Leicester last week when the action was withdrawn against the Rev. C. T. Moore, vicar of Appleby Magna. Mr. Hugo Young, K.C., who appeared for the prosecution, said that after Mr. Moore's evidence the prosecution accepted his statements unreservedly and entirely.

The Chancellor, in allowing the case to be withdrawn with costs against the prosecution, said that Mr. Moore had been found “more than not guilty.”
