

DEATH OF DR. A. DAVIDSON.

The death occurred at Appleby Magna rectory on Tuesday, following an apoplectic seizure, of Dr. Alexander Davidson, L.F.P. Surg., Glasg., who was widely known and highly esteemed in the district surrounding Appleby Magna, where he had resided for upwards of forty years. Dr. Davidson, who was 68 years of age, succeeded to the practice of Dr. Bowker and for about forty years was medical officer of the Austrey district of the Tamworth Union, a position which he resigned twelve months ago on account of failing health. Since then he had resided with the Rev. C. T. Moore, at Appleby Rectory. Dr. Davidson's clients held a high opinion of his skill as a medical practitioner. The funeral took place at Appleby Magna churebyard.
