HOUSING QUESTION. — At Ashby-de-la-Zouch Rural Council on Wednesday, Mr. F. C. Hunt complained that at Appleby, despite the fact that the Council received Government assistance in erecting houses intended for farm labourers, the cottages were being let to those who were not farm workers.—Several Councillors protested that Mr. Hunt was fighting against recommendations by the committee of which he was a member.—The Chairman (Mr. T. Varnam, J.P.): He has a perfect right to bring the matter forward.—With regard to a proposal to erect 30 houses at Measham and 30 at Oakthorpe and Donisthorpe, the Clerk said the Ministry of Health required certain information regarding the scheme.
