## Appleby Publican and Four Customers Fined

---

Hector Lionel Holbrook, licensee of the Moore's Arms, Appleby Magna, was at Ashby-de-la-Zouch Police Court on Saturday summoned for supplying beer otherwise than during permitted hours on March 20.

The publichouse is one of the oldest in Leicestershire, and over a century old.

The following four defendants were summoned for consuming the beer after permitted hours:—Percy John Stone, miner; Francis James Mear, farm labourer; Daniel Hulme, labourer, all of Appleby; and Richard Rounding, engine driver, of Norton Twycross.

Sergt. Redhead said at 10-45 p.m. he entered the publichouse by the door which was not locked. In the tap-room the four men were seated with the beer in front of them.

Holbrook was fined £5 5s., and the others one guinea each.
